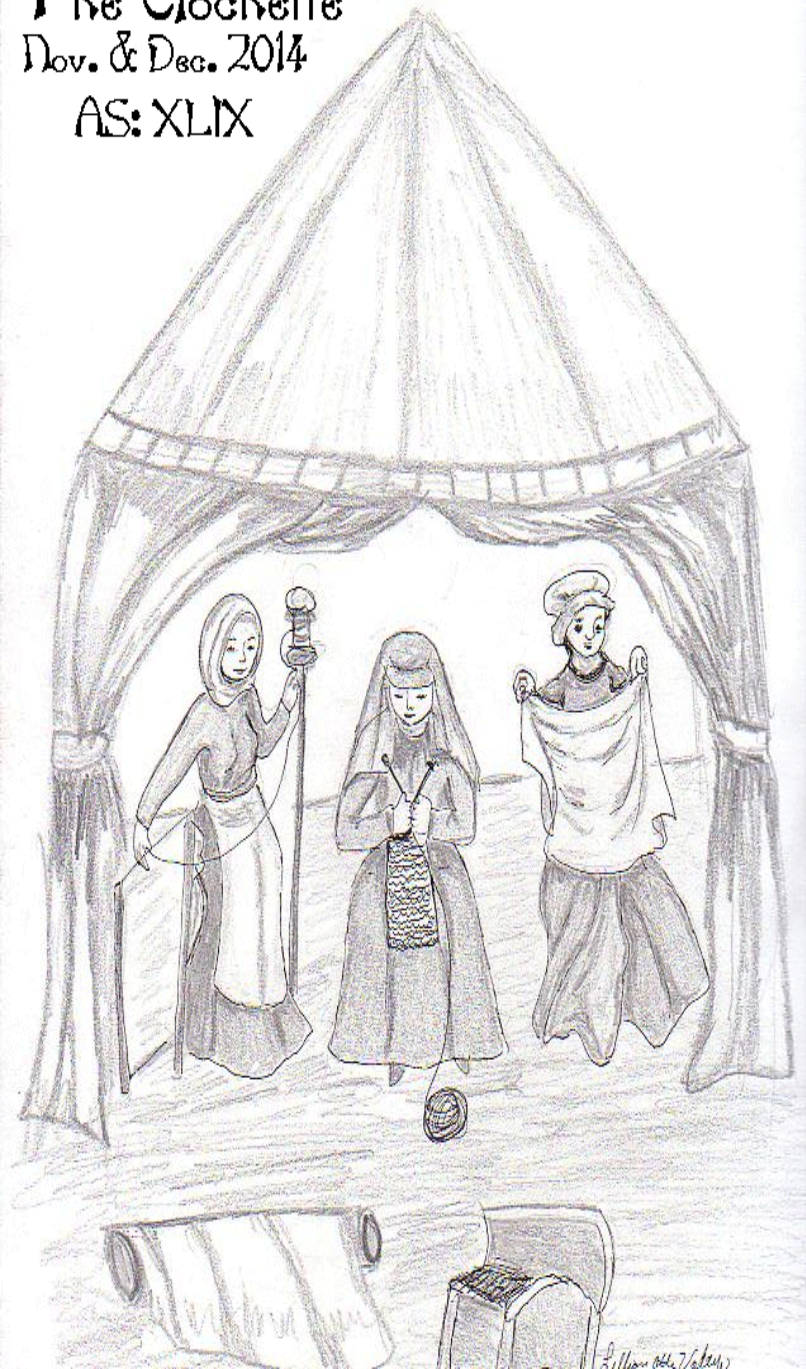

From the South:

Take the Garden State Parkway North to exit 90 toward Brick/Pt. Pleasant. Merge onto Chambers Bridge Rd/County
