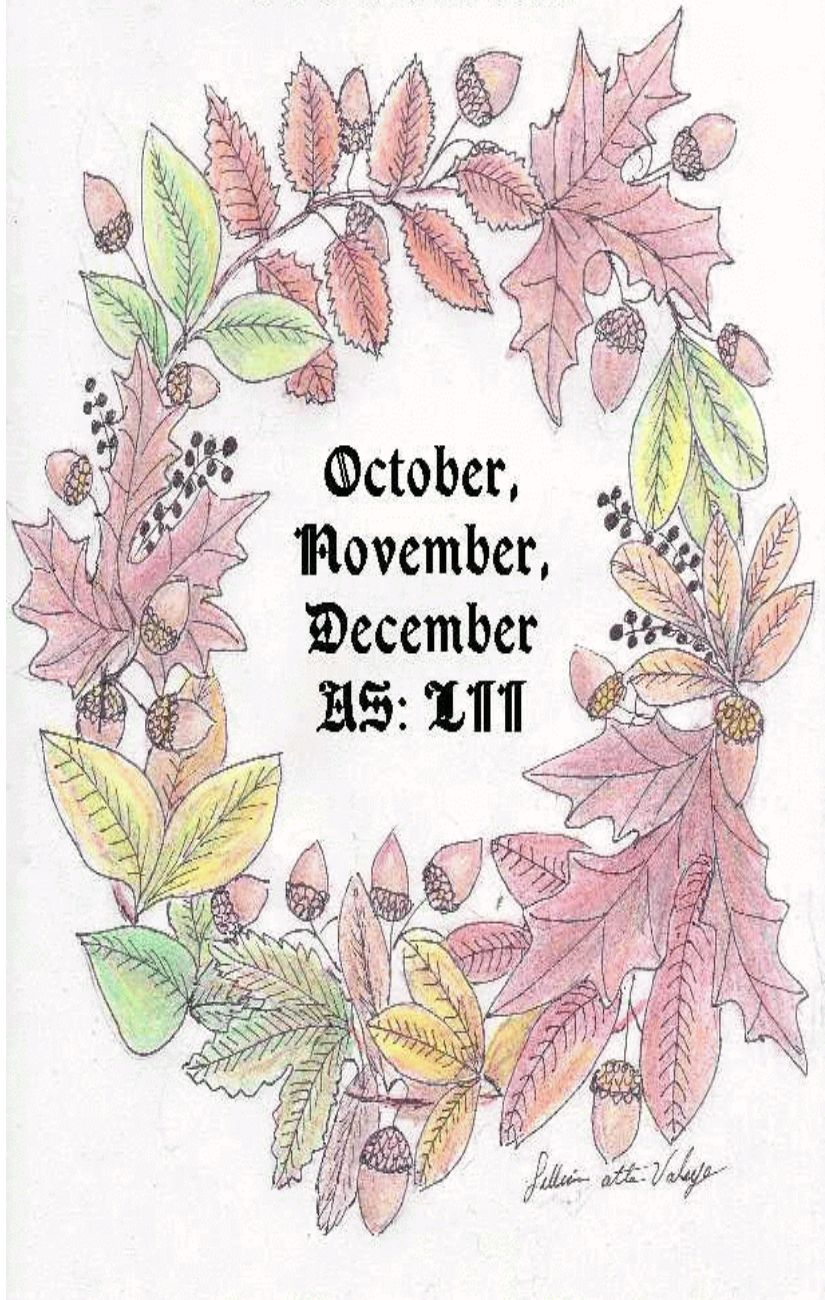

Adult Admission: \$21; discounted to \$16 for members

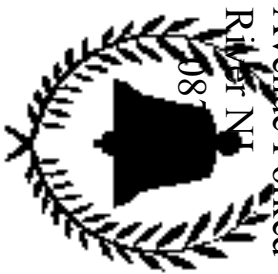
