From the Freehold area, proceed West on NJ Route 33 for six miles and go right on Route 527A North after the Mobil station (sign posted on traffic light at intersection says 527 / Iron Ore Road). Proceed 1/4 mile to LaValley Drive. Turn right on LaValley Drive and proceed 1/2 mile to troll.

#### Directions

**From the North** Best route to the Garden State Parkway southbound. Take Exit 91 and stay to the right on the exit ramp, towards Brick/Lakewood. Continue straight through the first light, and at the second light, turn right onto Route 526 west (Lanes Mill Road). \*\*Continue on this road to Route 9 (Exxon Station and Diner on corners), cross over and \*\*\*after approx. 1 mile you will see a golf course on your left, get into the left lane. Take the first left and follow the chain link fence to the first gate. Turn right into the gate and follow the road to the site.
