Unto Their Royal Majesties, Highnesses, and the Barony of Carillion do we, Ciaran ua Meic Thire and Ellynor Redpath send greetings,

While we have not lived in the barony for as long as many, having moved into Carillion in 2018 (AS 53), we say without hesitation or doubt to vou that Carillion and the East Kingdom are and will forever be our homes. He then told us to step inside one more time and, while still very confused, we complied and were told "great, you've been here three times now, you are family, welcome and please make yourself comfortable." It took us another 4 years to move into Carillion, but his words and his kindness have never left us. Carillion is where we feel that we belong. We strive to welcome others into the barony with the same enthusiasm and love that was shown to us whether as seated baronage or just as members of the populace.

Carillion itself began in the halls of Princeton University and its name was inspired by the bells of Westminster Choir College.
