

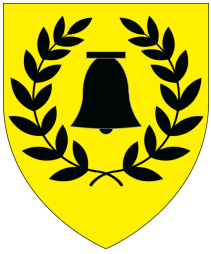

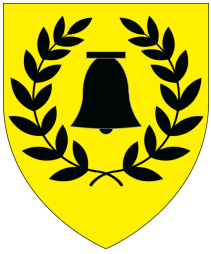

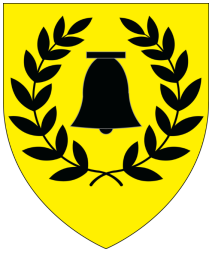
Message from the Outgoing Baronesses:

Pennsic Prep by Robert the Doubtful!

Now is really the time to start getting ready for Pennsic. Less than two months to go for a lot of people. The idea of "ah, lots of time left" gets smaller and smaller. So now you should be making lists, planning recipes -trying OUT recipes on a smaller scale, repairing garb and checking if the garb still fits and noting if the mice or moths haven't been feasting on your stuff over the winter. **GEAR!** Know where all your gear is NOW, not finding out the day before you leave that the items you KNEW were RIGHT THERE - ain't! Local camping events are great trial runs for your gear. It's a LOT better to discover you left your tent poles at home an hour away and not when at Pennsic 8 hours away!

LISTS! Lists are wonderful. I try to make a list with 3 check off blocks: Found, Staged, and Loaded. Don't wait till you get to Pennsic to find the batteries in your lanterns leaked or your camp chairs have gotten moldy in storage over the last 9 months. **PLENTY OF TIME.....NOW!** Put things into piles as you pull them out. Repair, Replace, Good to Go. Make a list of all the things you plan to bring and omit the stuff you can easily get there. Or buy it anyway here for cheaper and store it until you leave.

Take that list and print it out or get a special notebook with all the things on that list. Check off the items as you place them in a staging area - you might have to trip over them for a month, but they are there and not in some closet or storage unit. When you're ready to start actual vehicle loading **CHECK OFF AGAIN** every item in that list **AS** you load it. Make a final check as you actually put the stuff in your vehicle. It is not good to have a big bag of garb all ready to be loaded and still in your living room as you pull up to the gates.

SHELTER! First thing to consider is a suitable tent and some type of sleeping consideration. Directly on the ground is cold, a cot is better. A few blankets are nice. A sleeping bag over an air

mattress or a cot is better. An EZUP is nice in front of your tent. A table and chair can make it feel like home! Make sure your land agent knows the size of your set-up! Many camps take back an amount of space for camp common areas.

GARB! Everyone has to make at least some attempt at medieval garb - not elf ears, fairy wings, or vampire fangs, please. Inspect and start on new garb now, way before the event. Medieval footwear is nice but not absolutely necessary - and **DO NOT** try to break in a new pair of boots at Pennsic - **IT WILL HURT!** You will be doing a LOT of walking at Pennsic. It might really help if you got some walking practice a month or two prior to Pennsic if you live a mainly sedentary lifestyle (like me). We have weather at Pennsic. It **MIGHT** be in the 40's or 90's, deluge type rain with heavy winds or a comfortable misty rain - or bone dry. Plan your garb accordingly. Bring a set of modern clothes to keep in your car. It's always nice to know there is dry, clean clothing if needed!

COURTESY - Bring and practice. You don't have to sound like Shakespeare, but at least be nice to people.

Investigate the classes - pretty much anything you can think of medieval wise, will have at least one class!

SAFETY - Pennsic is big, really big! Travel with friends and know where you are camped! You should be drinking lots of water! A night at EMS because you are dehydrated is no fun! If you imbibe, keep track of your drinking. Be aware of what and how much you are drinking. Drink water along with alcohol. PA age rules for drinking are age 21. Bear that in mind - you get caught underage drinking or **GIVING** booze to someone underage - you **CAN** be asked to leave with no refund!

CAMPS - Don't go wandering into other camps. Hail the camp before entering. It's the polite thing to do! Pay attention to the camp's rules. Some camps are no -smoking, others are over 18 only.

Other considerations:

Meds of any kind - bring enough to last your entire stay. Eyeglasses - no problem, wear them.

Sunscreen - bring and wear, or buy there or in town.

Food - lot of places to eat there, but cheaper to bring your own - if you do bring your own, bring a cooler or two so said food does not turn pretty colors. There is a camp store and produce shop that has plenty of food items, tools, materials, corner store items, etc., plus a few large grocery stores nearby.

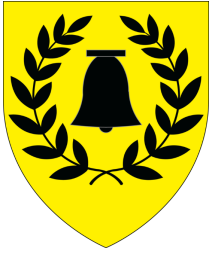
With a bit of preparation and planning you will have a fantastic Pennsic!!

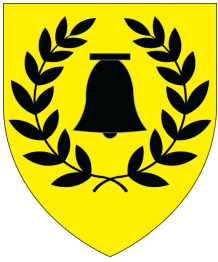
